



Champion's Contract:

In order to maintain a safe, respectful, and harmonious environment for all, it is our expectation that everyone from the youngest Quickstart player through the young adult elite player does his or her part to maintain appropriate behavior standards at all times so that strong performance is maximized on and off the court.

Expected Behavior at CCC Leagues, Matches, and Tournaments:

- Prepared and on time for practice
 - **Proper equipment according to the guidelines provided by the coach.**
 - **Filled water bottle**
 - **Proper, decent attire (tennis shoes with socks, shorts or sports clothing as appropriate)**
- 100% effort/focus for each session
- Always respectful to coaches, players, and facility
- Positive competitive attitude
- Willingness to listen and learn
- Notification ahead of time for absence or late arrival.

CCC Champion's Parents are expected to:

- Communicate with coaches or parents at appropriate times (not while the children are being coached)
- Refraining from making derogatory comments towards coaches, parents and children
- Picking up after yourselves and others as needed (matches, practices, and lessons)

Help the children respect their coaches and teammates by:

- Notifying the coaches in writing (as soon as possible) when a child will miss a practice or tennis match.

- Encouraging the children to communicate their concerns to their coach
- Helping the youngest children to get to events on time and encouraging them to participate in the entire competition- especially junior team tennis sessions
- Helping the children get to practice on time
- Ensuring that children come dressed in team attire for all meets and matches
- Volunteer as much as you are able at practices, matches, or tournaments

In addition, players are expected to be role models of the sport by displaying professional attitudes and actions to one another, all visiting players, and while participating in any tournament or event.

Upon enrollment at CCC, players are expected these guidelines. Each player and family must sign this behavior expectation agreement. CCC policies include zero-tolerance violations and if any of these are considered to be serious in nature and reflect profound disregard for the safety, health and well-being of staff and/or players can result in immediate expulsion with no refund.

CCC sets high expectations for players to maintain a healthy lifestyle (mentally and physically) in order to achieve the level of athleticism required to be a successful player both academically and athletically.
